NEW ONLINE LOCAL RESIDENT TICKETING SYSTEM

As in previous years we will be making entry to GlobalGathering available to eligible local residents for a charity donation of £50 per person. Some of the many local projects and charities that we will be supporting from these donations are listed below:

Community First Responder's, Defibrillators, Churches, Open Space Project, Shakespeare Hospice, Warwickshire & Northants Air Ambulance, Riding for the Disabled, Guide Dogs plus many other community projects of which we've had over 30 bids from the area this year.

With your help GlobalGathering Group hopes that following this year's GlobalGathering the total funds we will have raised for good causes will have exceeded £300,000.

Only residents who are on the electoral register for areas within approximately two miles of Long Marston Airfield qualify for local resident entry. These areas include Lower Quinton, Upper Quinton, Clifford Chambers, Long Marston, Welford, Dorsington, Pebworth, Preston on Stour and Admington.

Due to high demand in 2013, GlobalGathering has increased the number of tickets allocated to local residents by 200 in 2014. Entry numbers are limited to 1400 tickets only and allocated on a first come, first served basis via the new online ticketing system. Please note there is no guarantee that you will be able to obtain a ticket.

The online system will be live during a 2-week period, allowing residents more time to apply for tickets this year. The first allocation of tickets goes on sale on **Monday 30th June to Friday 4th July** (or until sold out); the second allocation of tickets goes on sale on **Monday 7th July to Friday 11th July** (or until sold out) from www.globalgathering.com/localresidents.

Entry will be via wristband only which will be available to collect from the box office at the festival site situated on the runway past the Aerolite Flying Club from 4pm to 8pm on Wednesday 23rd and Thursday 24th July 2014.

Resident wristbands will not be on sale on the days of the festival, and will not be available outside the times stated above or from any other location. Terms and Conditions apply, please visit the website www.globalgathering.com. GlobalGathering Group reserves the right to refuse to sell you a wristband.

A Maximum of 2 tickets can be purchased online per household subject to availability.

Local residents wishing to attend the festival must attend in person to obtain their wristband, which is non transferable.

Entry to the festival will be refused if the wristband is damaged. To obtain a wristband you must bring the following ID:

- Photographic Driving License with a qualifying address on.



- Paper Driving License with a qualifying address on plus matching Passport.
- A print out of the ticket voucher from Ticketmaster.

You must be over 18 to attend the festival and ID will be checked at the gate.

The wristband will allow you to gain access to the festival on a General Admission basis and you must enter the festival via the public entrance on the event days. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission.

The music stages operate during the following times:

- From 5pm on Friday 25th July to 3am on Saturday 26th July.
- From 12pm on Saturday 26th July to 4am on Sunday 27th July.

Outside of these times we will be testing the systems for a couple of hours before the festival opens. These tests will happen no earlier than 12pm on Thursday 24th July and will be agreed with Environmental Health at Stratford-upon-Avon District Council.
